- Classes are scheduled to run **Monday** and **Wednesday** evenings from 06:00 PM to 10:00 PM. You should wear comfortable, but appropriate clothing.
- This certification program is a two-part certification process. The student will complete the Emergency Medical Technician Basic (EMT-B) course and upon completion, will take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) psychomotor and cognitive adaptive examination.
- Additional course requirements outlined in the National EMS Education Standards such as Hazardous Materials Awareness, Incident Command System (ICS 100), and NIMS 700 certifications will need to be completed independently, and satisfied prior to the certification examination. Students will also need to complete a total of ten patient encounters throughout the course of the program.
- Students less than 18 years of age must have a parental consent form signed to sit for the certification exam. Students are not eligible to test until they are 16 years of age.
- Accepted candidates will receive a letter of acceptance on the basis of rolling admissions. Students must have the necessary mental acuity, practical skills, motivation, and mental attitude necessary to complete the program. Students adhere to the physical performance guidelines as outlined in the *Pennsylvania Department of Health Functional Position Description for EMT-Basic*. In addition, the candidates must possess the perseverance to provide quality patient care, even under difficult circumstances.
- **Tuition:** EMT-B Course **\$650.00** – minimum deposit of \$150.00 due by the first day of class. The remaining balance must be satisfied by the completion of the class, and should be made payable to **Mutual Aid Ambulance Service, Inc.**, unless other arrangements have been made. Tuition includes EMT textbook, class materials, uniform shirt, and required testing fees.
- **This program will provide you with the necessary certifications needed to meet the entry level requirements for employment in EMS. Completion of the program does not guarantee your certification as an EMT-B.**
