**MUTUAL AID EXPANDING COVERAGE AREA IN FAYETTE COUNTY
TO SERVE SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP**

GREENSBURG (September 2, 2020) – Mutual Aid Ambulance Service, Inc. today announced its designation by the Board of Supervisors of Springfield Township, Fayette County, as the sole and exclusive provider of emergency medical services for the township.

“We are honored and privileged to expand our service to Fayette County residents,” said Scot Graham, Mutual Aid Chief Operations Officer. “We take seriously the trust placed in us by the Springfield Supervisors to care for their residents at their times of most urgent need, and are pleased to provide our nationally-recognized patient-centered care from another new station in Fayette County.”

Effective immediately, Mutual Aid will provide an Advanced Life Support Paramedic and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) crew at the Saltlick Volunteer Fire Department station in Indian Head that will be staffed 24-hours a day, seven days a week, as well as the Bullskin Township Fire Department in Wooddale. These resources are in addition to Mutual Aid’s long-standing station in Stahlstown.

Residents are reminded that all emergency requests should continue to be placed through 911.

Mutual Aid Ambulance Service, Inc. will continue to honor ambulance memberships purchased by Springfield residents from Fayette EMS until March 31, 2021. Those interested in a new Mutual Aid membership, which offers reduced copays and reduced rates for doctor’s office transports, can join on-line at www.mutual-aid.com/membership or by calling 724-837-6134.

Springfield Township covers approximately 60-square miles in the northeastern portion of Fayette County, with nearly 3,000 residents.

In July, Mutual Aid received the same designation from neighboring Bullskin Township.

Mutual Aid Ambulance Service is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization that provides emergency and medical transportation for more than 200,000 residents throughout 30 municipalities over nearly

900-square miles in Westmoreland, Fayette and Somerset counties, utilizing 15 strategically-placed stations that are fully staffed and fully-equipped every day, 24-hours a day, all-year. Mutual Aid maintains a fully-accredited Training Center for Paramedic and Emergency Medical Technician Certification and to train businesses, nonprofits, youth groups, fire departments and individuals on CPR, AED and First Aid.

Mutual Aid Ambulance Service, Inc. is licensed by the PA Department of Health and is recognized as an American Heart Association *Mission: Lifeline* “Gold Plus” provider.
