- Classes are scheduled *Monday and Wednesday evening from 06:00 PM to 10:00 PM*. You should wear comfortable, but appropriate clothing.
- This certification program is a two-part certification process. The student will complete the Emergency Medical Technician Basic (EMT-B) course and upon completion, will take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) psychomotor and cognitive adaptive examination.
- Additional course requirements outlined in the National EMS Education Standards such as Hazardous Materials Awareness, ICS 100, and NIMS 700 certifications will need to be completed independently, and satisfied prior to the certification examination. Students will also need to complete ten patient encounters throughout the course of the program. As a result of the need to be patient facing, all students must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or have an appropriately documented religious or medical exemption.
- Students must be at least 16 years of age to enroll in the program. Students less than 18 years of age must have a parental consent form signed to sit for the certification exam.
- Accepted candidates will receive a letter of enrollment on the basis of rolling admissions. Students must
 have the necessary mental acuity, practical skills, motivation, and mental attitude necessary to complete the
 program. Students must adhere to the physical performance guidelines as outlined in the *Pennsylvania*Department of Health Functional Position Description for EMT-Basic. In addition, the candidates must
 possess the perseverance to provide quality patient care, even under difficult circumstances.
- **Tuition**: EMT-B Course \$700.00 <u>tuition</u> is due in full upon arrival at the first day of class. Checks should be made payable to <u>Mutual Aid Ambulance Service</u>, <u>Inc.</u> No cash will be accepted. Tuition payments will not be accepted prior to the first night of class. Tuition includes the required testing fees.
- **Textbook**: AAOS Emergency Care and Transportation of the Sick and Injured, 12th Edition ISBN# 9781284246223. Students will be responsible for purchasing a textbook prior to the first day of class.
- This program will provide you with the necessary certifications needed to meet the entry-level requirements for employment in EMS. <u>Completion of the program does not guarantee your</u> <u>certification as an EMT-B.</u>
